TOUR HIGHLIGHTS:

- 1) Anuradhapura : UNESCO World Heritage Site – visit ancient palaces and temples. It was founded 1,300 years ago and houses the oldest recorded religious tree – the Sri Maha Bodhi Tree planted in 3rd BC.
- 2) Jaffna : Capital of the Northern Province of Sri Lanka. Now rediscovering new development and prosperity after 3 decades of civil strife. There are numerous lagoons and islands in the area. Seafood is abundant here and is famous for its Jaffna Crab curry. We will visit Point Pedro at the Northern most point of Sri Lanka and have an opportunity to by local wine made by a nunnerly.
- 3) Passikuda : A beach resort. So just enjoy the clean beaches, seafood and sea activities.
- 4) Sigiriya : A UNESCO World Heritage site – visit and climb the Sigiriya Rock Fortress, one of the best preserved examples of ancient urban planning built around 450 AD. Technological marvels used then are still operating today. Experience boating on the lake, bullock cart ride and a elephant back ride.
- 5) Kandy : A UNESCO World Heritage site, is the last Royal capital of ancient Sri Lankan kings. Houses the sacred Temple of the Tooth (relic of the tooth of Lord Buddha) (<http://sridaladamaligawa.lk/>) Kandy is also a shopping haven for tourists.
- 3) Nuwara Eliya : This was the favorite hill station of the British (much like Cameron Highlands or Frasers Hill in Malaysia). It is at an altitude of 1,868 m or 6,128 feet above sea level). The roads are good and provide spectacular views for riders. The area is surrounded by tea plantations and many waterfalls.
