Rule amendment, Creation of an Exhibition Class, to allow riders to move freely within our class structure, without influencing the outcome of event standings or year end points.

Definition or Description of Exhibition Class.

The exhibition class is designed to allow riders to move up or down from their Championship Series class, before or during an Event, without collecting points (event or series) on that day.

Including but not limited to,

- A) Rider injury where rider feels it is unsafe to compete in his/her assigned class but does not want to miss the opportunity to ride said event, includes injuries occurring during said event.
- B) Bike issues, rider feels that for whatever reasons the current bike they are operating does not allow them to feel safe or competitive in their assigned class.
- C) Riders moving up a class to test their skills at a higher level for said event
- D) Pro riders making one time appearances at a D4 event, promoter could develop EXHIBITION lines to accommodate pro riders, if given sufficient notice

In the event of Exhibition class ride, riders will be scored on the line they have chosen to ride that event ( full or partial event )they will use the provided stickers to modify their front plate to show the new class they are riding, scores will be recorded on our official scoreboard for reference purposes only, rider will finish the event with a DNF/DNS for their official class as well as the class they entered.

NO EVENT POINTS or SERIES POINTS will be awarded during an EXHIBITION RIDE.
